Setauket: *Eclectic and International*, the **30th annual Long Island Guitar Festival** will be held **May 11 to 15, 2022** at the **Setauket Presbyterian Church** in Setauket, NY.

The 30th Annual Long Island Guitar Festival Will Feature Grammy Winner David Russell (first L.I. performance) As It Presents World-Class Performances By Internationally Renowned Guitarists.

The 2022 Guitar Festival is presented in partnership with the **Setauket Presbyterian Church** and the **Oberon Foundation.** The Long Island Guitar Festival represents an ongoing commitment to reach out to the arts community here and abroad and continue its established tradition of excellence in guitar performance and pedagogy.

Founded in 1993 by **Harris Becker**, this international event provides a unique opportunity to hear world-class artists in person as well as watch them teach master classes, conduct workshops, and perform in concert. The festival also features the seventh annual **National High School Guitar Competition** and **High School Guitar Ensemble Showcases**.

Island Guitar Festival by April 28, 2022.
